### HOLIDAY TREE COLLECTION OPTIONS

#### SPECIAL CONTAINER

Republic will drop off a roll-off container for compostable holiday trees. We recommend you reserve yours as early as possible

#### SPECIAL PICKUP

Complexes with no space for a roll-off box, or too small to warrant one, can designate a drop-off area and schedule a collection day directly with Republic.

#### EXTRA COLLECTIONS

Arrange for your containers to be serviced more often than usual in January.

Alternatively, residents may also self-haul trees to the nearest drop-off location.

- Union City- Tri-CED Community Recycling- 33377 Western Ave, January 3-31, 2017

A few things to keep in mind:

- Non-compostable trees (no flocked, artificial, ornaments, or stands) are not eligible for tree collection. They should be placed in trash containers, cut small enough so lid will close.
- Keep areas in and around enclosures free of trees and extra trash so Republic can service your regular bins and carts.
- Drivers cannot service containers if items are piled higher than the edge of the box.
