Dear Residents: Please help avoid clutter and fire hazards by properly disposing of your holiday tree.



Compostable Trees

- Benefit the environment and free up trash container space.
- Avoid buying trees with flocking or fire retardant.
- Remove decorations, tinsel, nails, and stands before discarding.
- Do not overfill containers (items piled higher than the edge of the box).

Non-Compostable Trees

- Trees with flocking, fire retardant, decorations, tinsel, tree stands.
- Cut up and place in the garbage container.
- Do not place trees next to containers or inside trash enclosures.
- Do not overfill containers (items piled higher than the edge of the box).

Other options:

- Self-haul your tree to Republic Services, at 42600 Boyce Rd. in Fremont and place in the roll-off box in the parking lot. Available December 26–January 31, 2017.
- Self-haul your tree to Tri-CED Community Recycling in Union City, 33377 Western Ave. Available January 3–31, 2017.
