Important Changes in Plastic Recycling

Due to global market changes, only the following plastics are now recyclable loose in the recycling cart: plastic milk jugs, pop/soda bottles, fruit juice bottles and jugs, and detergent jugs.

- » No plastic marked with the #3 through #7 recycling symbol (on the bottom of the container) is allowed in the recycling cart.
- » No plastic film of any kind (grocery bags, trash bags, shrink wrap, bubble wrap, etc.) is allowed.

Changes in plastics recycling are industry wide. Our local recycling center can accept the plastics #1 and #2 shown on the front of this card. Please keep other plastics, which are considered contaminants, out of the recycling cart, in order to ensure recycling stays out of the landfill.
