



Bellevue Residential Rates – effective as of January 1, 2018

All garbage rates include unlimited recycling and up to 192 gallons (96-gallon cart plus up to three additional units of 32-gallons each) of organics service per week. Prices below subject to applicable taxes and the King County Hazardous Waste Fee.

Container Sizes

Extra Recycling	No charge	Box, bundle or bag in paper bags, label "recycling" and place next to recycling cart.

Organics (yard debris and food scraps)	Monthly Rate for Weekly Service (billed quarterly)	Special Preparation
One 96-gallon cart (default)	Included	No plastic bags. Only Cedar Grove approved compostable bags.
Extra 96-gallon cart rental fee (per month)	\$2.66	
Extra can/bag/bundle per week, per 32 gallons	\$5.02	Place in can, paper bags or boxes not to exceed 32 gallons or 60 lbs. Label extras "yard waste". No food scraps of food soiled paper outside of organics cart.

Bulky waste - large appliances, furniture, large televisions, mattresses.	\$95.59	Call to schedule pick-up. 425-452-4762
Fluorescent tubes and bulbs	Included	Limit 2 tubes/bulbs per collection. Limit 10 tubes/bulbs per year. Tubes must be no longer than 4 ft. Wrap tubes in newspaper and secure with tape. Place bulbs in a sealed bag. Place next to recycling container. Mark "fluorescent tubes."
Household batteries (alkaline, button and rechargeable)	Included	Place rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries in separate, clear, sealed bags. Set on top of recycling container.
Plastic bags and film (all clean, dry plastic shopping or produce bags, and plastic film)	Included	Contaminated plastic bags such as cheese and meat wrappers, bags with paper labels, and bags with food or other residues are excluded. Place all plastic bags and film inside of one bag and tie to secure.
Rigid plastics (5 gallon buckets, PVC pipe, laundry baskets, plastic lawn furniture, Big Wheels, coolers and Nalgene bottles)	Included	One dimension of the object must be less than 2 ft. Place items in cart or next to recycling cart. Call to schedule pickup for larger items. 425-452-4762
Scrap metal	Included	All ferrous and non-ferrous scrap metal, including lids larger than 3" that is free of wood, plastic, rubber and other contaminants.
Small appliances (microwave ovens, toaster ovens, irons)	Included	Limit 2'x2'x2' or smaller and less than 60 lbs. Call to request pick-up. 425-452-4762 Set on top of or next to recycling container on specified day.
Small electronics (computer equipment, audio equipment TVs, cell phones, MP3 players)	Included	Limit 2'x2'x2' or smaller and less than 60 lbs. Call to request pick-up. 425-452-4762 Place in clear plastic bag. Set on top of or next to recycling container on specified day.
Textiles	Included	Call to request pick-up. 425-452-4762 Place clean, dry clothing and household textiles in clear plastic bag and place on or next to recycling container on specified day.
Used cooking oil (FOG - fats, oil, grease)	Included	Limit 3 gallons per drop-off or pick-up. Limit 10 total gallons per year. Seal uncontaminated oil (no large solids) in clean, clear, screw-top plastic jugs. Label jugs with name and address. Place next to recycling container.
